

Video Clip for the European Day of Languages Competition

Competition Terms of Reference

**1. General conditions**

The competition is open to school pupils and students.

To take part in this competition you should be between 12 and 26 years old.

Every participant will confirm his/her age when registering:

- 12-15 years old: school pupils
- 15-18 years old: college and lyceum students
- 18-26 years old: university and institute students

The video clip can be an individual or team work: pupils and students can create their individual work or a team work (the team should not consist of more than

three/3 people). The teams can be formed of students or pupils learning English, German and French languages.

## **2. Competition Subject**

12-15 years old category: The participants should tell in their video clip about one day from their everyday lives.

15-18 and 18-26 years old category: The participants should create a video clip in which they will tell about the importance of learning a foreign language today and how important it is for their future employability and career.

**Length of the video clip:** from 1,5 to 3 minutes.

**Language:** the video clip can be created in German and/or English, French languages or any other foreign language and at the same time in one of the languages spoken in Uzbekistan, Uzbek, Russian, Tajik, etc. if this is on your scenario. The video clips that use different languages are welcomed.

### **3. Registration and taking part.**

The participants should:

- **Fill in the application form “Video Clip for the European Day of Languages!”** which is available on the websites of the British Council (*put the web link here*), French embassy website [www.ambafrance-uz.org](http://www.ambafrance-uz.org) , and Goethe Institut website [www.goethe.de/ins/uz/ru/tas.html](http://www.goethe.de/ins/uz/ru/tas.html) and websites of other organisers.

- **Send the application form to [emine.sheykhametova@britishcouncil.org](mailto:emine.sheykhametova@britishcouncil.org) by September 10, 2016**

You can also use the free file sending website [www.wetransfer.com](http://www.wetransfer.com) to send your video clip to us. This website is used for sending big files.

- **It is important** to indicate in your email subject line the main language of your video clip, for example: Video Clip in English/Video Clip in French/Video Clip in German/Video Clip in Several languages/ etc.

### **4. Selection**

12 video clips in each category, created in English, French and German will be selected by the panel of judges that will consist of representatives of various embassies and cultural centres. 36 best videos will be showcased during the celebration of the European day of Languages. More details on this event will follow up later.

### **5. Awards and Results**

The winners will be awarded during the celebration of the European Day of Languages. There are also special prizes.

The video clips will be published on the websites and social media channels of the French Embassy, British Council and Goethe Institut and other partners upon the consent received from the authors.

**The results will be announced at the end of September during the celebration of the European day of Languages. The date and venue for the celebration will be announced later.**

### **6. General terms**

- The following criteria will be considered for the selection of the video clips: language quality, following the competition conditions, creativity, and innovativeness, as well as **technical parameters** of the video – it should be of a resolution to be demonstrable on a large screen. The panel of judges will consider the subtitles, if any.
- Educational Institutions (schools, colleges, lyceums, institutes, universities, languages centres, etc.) can apply with several video clips.
- The final selection decisions will closed for appeal.

- The organising committee has the right for creation of a general video clip using the works received. This clip will be showcased at the opening of the European day of languages.
